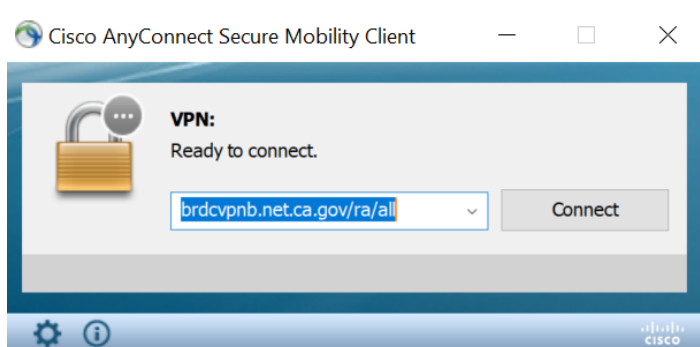
Download Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client and install it on your computer.

Download for Windows

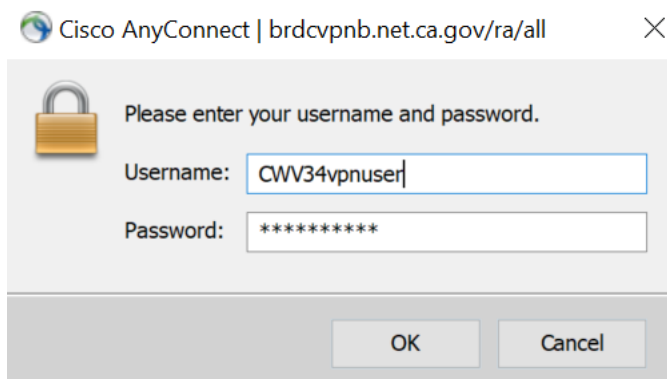
Download and install the AnyConnect VPN Client.

## Connecting using the Cisco AnyConnect Client.

Open the AnyConnect Client.



Type the site address as “brdcvpnb.net.ca.gov/ra/all” and click “Connect”.



Type in the user credentials and click “OK”. If the connection was successful an icon with a lock will be displayed in the lower right-hand corner system tray.

To disconnect, right click the system tray icon and click “disconnect”.
